

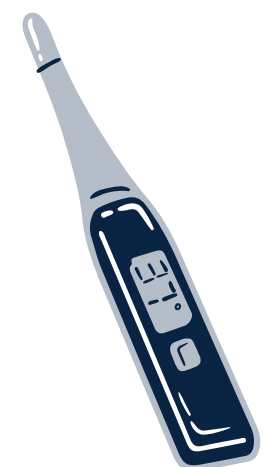
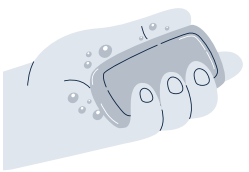
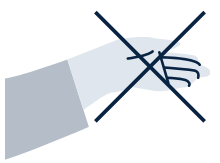
# Little Blossoms COVID-19 Procedure

Little Blossom Day Nursery recognised the government guideline and have followed them. We have taken the following procedures below during this time of lockdown. Catering to the families who filled in the nursery closure forms, so the nursery could practice these procedures.

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## Children

- We have a limited number of children (key workers, vulnerable children and look after's)
- The outdoor swing and slide have been closed for use.
- Soft toys and carpet have been put away.
- Draws with trays were put out of reach.
- Following the government guidelines of social distancing, 2-meter line stickers at the entrances of the nursery have been placed on the ground to avoid parent's nearby proximity to staff and other parents. Each child/siblings enter at a time.
  - Parents wait outside in the entrances at drop off and pick up at the 2-meter sticker.
  - Staff members sign children in and out of the nursery.
- When children enter the nursery that must remove their shoes and wash their hands. They wear alternative shoes in the garden.
- Children play in their bubbles; siblings play together while others have their bubbles.
- Lunchtime- siblings sit together and only children sit the heads of a table at a distance.
- Children's temperature is taken twice a day (when the children enter the setting and in the afternoon). If the child has a temperature their parents are contacted immediately to collect the child.
- Throughout the day children wash their hands and use hands satisfiers.
- All children must bring their own blanket and are spread out and separated during sleep
- Parents are given time slots to collect children to avoid multiple parents outside waiting from 4:30 pm
- The nursery closes early to observe the system of control fully, to be ready for the following day. Even though, sterilisation and disinfecting of resources are done during the day.
- Parents should call the nursery when they are outside. The same applies for early pickup.
- Before children leave the setting, they wash their hands and put their shoes on.
- Children bring in their own water bottles and 2 small toys with their name on it.



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## Staff

- Staff must be in clean uniforms every shift and change into uniform when they arrive; every member of staff's temperature is taken on arrival.
- Regularly washing hands and using sanitizer.
- Wearing PPE (Aprons were changed every 3 hours)
- Gloves when changing nappies or dealing with children's self-care
- There are different aprons for meals and day to day – (Blue apron & gloves for meal times and white apron and gloves for nappies and day to day).

## General (including planning)

- Following the lockdown menu, which is reduced and made simple (because there was no Nursery Cook or resources).
- Following the lockdown planning with reduced, play activity resources, which are cleaned after use
- All indoor area is deeply cleaned and disinfected at the end of each day, especially Fridays (. i.e. nursery hour has been reduced from 8 am to 6 pm, to 8:30 am to 5 pm) to facilitate the cleaning process.
- Daily cleaning table, surfaces touched and toys played with.
- Deep cleaning furniture moved and cleaned – sterilising of all toys used and windows doors and gates.

## Kitchen

- Keep working as usual
